COMMON QUESTIONS

1. I am an awesome person with a great idea – will you fund me?

No. We fund research projects for programs that are already up and running.

- 2. I am teaching a class and want to collect data about the outcomes, can you help me? Yes. Schedule an appointment with the director to discuss your project. Read over the guidelines and be prepared to answer the first 5 questions. The director will provide guidance about ways to conduct research and provide potential survey options for your use.
 - 3. I have a program up and running and I want to do some high-quality research do you fund projects like this?

YES! We provide funding on a case by case basis and are always looking down the road for great projects. Your first step is to set up an appointment with the director (434-218-9500 / info@3prc.com) and discuss your project. Download the guidelines and answer all the questions. Once you have taken the steps needed to lay out the project, the goals and who would conduct the research (all of which the director can support you with), then you will have a meeting with the funder (Ron McVety) to discuss funding your project!

- 4. What if I want to fund another three principles project? Something that is not research? At this time, we are only funding the research projects associated with three principles programs. We are not funding, movies, books, or new 3P outreach.
 - 5. Are there other ways I can help 3P research without running a project?
